Members have also been working to source and service second hand bikes. This has largely been through the generosity of local people giving up bikes that have been gathering dust in the garage or shed.




Thank you to St John's Church Moulsham for helping us administrate and distribute these bikes and thank you to the local community for being such generous hosts!

They wanted to improve the experience of others who go through such an unimaginable situaion by creating "Memory Boxes" which provide an array of items to allow the family to create lasting memories of their lost loved one, and "Daddy Angel Cards" to provide a keep sake for the Fathers to keep that paternal connection and provide some support in a situation where they are not normally catered for.
